SUPPORTING EMOTIONAL NEEDS

Children are removed from their homes for physical abuse, drug abuse, neglect, and often come into foster care with only the clothes on their back. These children struggle with emotional needs and physical needs.

We are meeting the basic necessities for foster children by providing clothing, shoes, diapers, beds, car seats, hygiene items and meals for foster families who are stepping up to care for atrisk children in their homes.

PS I Love You hosts multiple events throughout the year to support as many children as possible. Some children may only be in Spartanburg County for a few days or months until they are transferred to another part of the state.
