This will be a walk through experience that will follow the life of a child as they enter foster care and move into a new home. Participants will also learn how we point children to the hope of Jesus. Children in our community are regularly brought into the foster care system and we are blessed to be a positive part of their journey. At the end of the walk through experience, the little girl ask me “Ms. Kay why do you do all this?” It was a question that was easy for me to answer. Here's why we do what we do.....

..... Many years ago I was a foster parent and we brought foster children into our home. But I did not have a place to call for resources like we have here at PSILY. God always provided for all our foster children, and we never went without. Through fostering, I began to have a heavy burden for children without a home, without clothes, without stability, and without basic necessities.....

A few years later, I approached another foster mom to share my burdens and asked her to pray with me. Our prayer was for God to show us what to do and how to help. PS I Love You is the answer to that prayer that we prayed many years ago.

God always supplies all of the things here at PSILY through our community and we are able to share the hope of Jesus with many children in foster care.

I want you to hear my heart, we count it a **privilege** that God allows us to serve **HIS** kids!

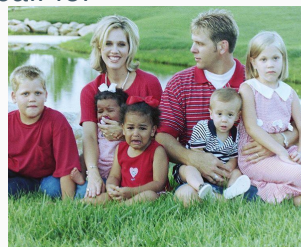
We welcome them with open arms on His behalf!
